ASSIGNMENT 1

Instruction: Ch 8 Special Senses (complete within 5 days)

- Option 1 Read Chapter 8 in your textbook or the information about the Special Senses in an online textbook.
- **Option 2** Internet Activities.
 - 1. On the SHS school website, click on Class Webpages. Scroll down and click on Callahan, Ellen.
 - 2. Scroll down and on the left side of the screen, click on the Ch 8 Special Senses link.
 - 3. On the new page, click on the <u>Animations</u> link. Select from the list to view videos explaining 1) the eye and vision, 2) the ear, hearing, and balance, 3) smell, 4) taste. Close that tab and return to the Anatomy Ch 8 webpage.
 - 4. Scroll down and right click on the <u>Eye and Ear Labeling Practice I</u> link, open in a new window. In the new window, scroll down to the section labeled <u>Eyes and Ears</u>. Complete the exercises. Click the back button as you complete each one to select the next exercise. Close that tab and return to the Anatomy Ch 8 webpage.
 - 5. Scroll down and right click on the <u>Labeling Practice II</u> link, open in a new window. Scroll down to <u>The Special Senses</u> section. Complete the labeling activities. Close that tab and return to the Anatomy Ch 8 webpage.
 - 6. Complete the labeling activities found on the <u>Ear Structures</u> AND <u>Eye Structures</u> links. Close that tab and return to the Anatomy Ch 8 webpage.
 - 7. Click on the Ear and Hearing AND Eye Structures and Vision links to watch animations of vision and hearing.

 - 1. Draw and label functional structures of the 1) eye, 2) ear, 3) olfactory epithelium in the nasal cavity, and 4) tongue.
 - 2. Explain the process of vision. Include 1) the pathway of light, 2) the differences between distance vision and near vision (focusing far and near), 3) the photoreceptors that function in low light and different types for color vision.
 - 3. Explain the process of hearing. Include 1) the pathway of vibrations through the ear structures to the cochlear nerve, 2) the names and locations of the fluids within the cochlea.

4. Explain the process of maintaining balance. Include 1) the structures involved with static equilibrium, 2) an explanation of the what happens when your head position changes in relation to the pull of gravity, 3) the structures involved with dynamic equilibrium, 2) an explanation of the what happens when your head position changes when you are in motion.

 - b. One page or more about how the cells and chemicals of the internal defenses protect. Include a description of at least 8 mechanisms of the second line of defense. Include a detailed description of what happens during the Inflammatory Response.
 - c. One page or more about how the Immune Response (third line of defense) fights infections and provides specific immunity. Include an explanation of how antibodies are formed and how immunity is achieved.
 - 2. And one page explaining how vaccines work on your immune system to provide immunity.
