### Task 1

For those of you who did not get the full opportunity of peer review, use the sample papers in the Sample Paper file to guide you in critiquing and revising your own paper.
- 2. If you need to find and use more source to get to that comfortable 20-25 number, then take the time to do that and incorporate them into your paper. Remember to add them to your annotated bib.
- 3. Upload your Lit Rev/Methods section into the Paper section in Class Notebook
- 4. The deadline for this is Friday, 3/20.

## **Methods and Results Activity**

- 1. The purpose of this activity is to have you inspect scholarly sources in order to see required elements from the rubric in context. The focus at this point is the second part of the paper.
- 2. 13 Research papers are in the Sample Papers File of Class Notebook in One Note. Read through the papers to find which ones are most like your own work. You may not find the "perfect fit," but find ones that have similar research styles and formats.
- 3. Choose 3 and complete the chart below (see attached) for each one. Fill it out completely, but focus on the results, discussion of the results, situating, implications, limitations, and conclusion.
- 4. If you need help discerning each section, use the annotated paper <u>Violent video gaming and moral</u> <u>reasoning in adolescents: is there an association?</u> (In the file) as a reference.
- 6. Submit each of your reviews separately in the "Paper" section of your Class Notebook.
- 7. The deadline for Task 2 is Friday, 3/27.
- 8. E-Mail both Mrs. Harris and Mrs. Jutzeler when you have completed Task 2.
