# ILT/SLT/DETENTION

## ILT - Independent Learning Time

Students will use this time to eat lunch, read, work on assignments, and hang out with their friends.

Students will be allowed in the cafeteria, courtyard, media center, grade level classrooms, and fine arts classrooms. Students may choose to check in with a teacher for tutoring and then go outside to visit with their friends. We only ask that students do not just wander the halls. Also, students are expected to clean up after themselves at all locations.

## SLT - Structure Learning Time

Students will be assigned SLT if they have a 65 or below in any class OR if they are missing assignments. SLT will also be used for a time for students to receive tutoring or extra help. If a student is assigned SLT by a teacher, this takes the place of ILT for that day. Students will still be allowed to eat their lunch, but they must do so in that teacher's room while they are receiving tutoring or working on assignments.

## Detention

If a student receives a detention, they will serve with the teacher who assigned the detention. Detentions are served during ILT for 20 minutes. After a student has earned their fourth detention in a quarter, admin will assign the student BIR.
