The IDEA terms listed below are the categories of disability that an individual can be found to have after evaluation and subsequently be eligible for services under IDEA. Each one of the terms has its' own continuum of severity.

Autism Multiple Disabilities

Deaf-blindness Orthopedic Impairment

Deafness OHI (Other Health Impairment)

Developmental delay SLD (Specific Learning Disability)

Emotional disturbance Speech/Language Impairment

Hearing impairment TBI (Traumatic Brain Injury)

Intellectual disability Visual Impairment (Blindness)
