Unprotected sex

Sharing needles

Passing HIV from an infected mother to baby either during pregnancy, delivery or breast milk

Through what 4 body fluids is HIV commonly transmitted?

Blood

Semen

Vaginal secretions

Breast milk

What are 3 common sexual practices that are HIV-risk related?

Anal sex, oral sex, and vaginal sex

How is HIV NOT transmitted?

Touching, massaging, sharing eating utensils, contact with toilet seats, doorknobs, sharing drinking cups, or mosquitoes

What measures can you take to help prevent acquiring HIV/AIDS?

Using latex condoms or dental dams every time you have vaginal, oral or anal sex

Not sharing needles (including needles for tattoos, piercing and steroid use)
