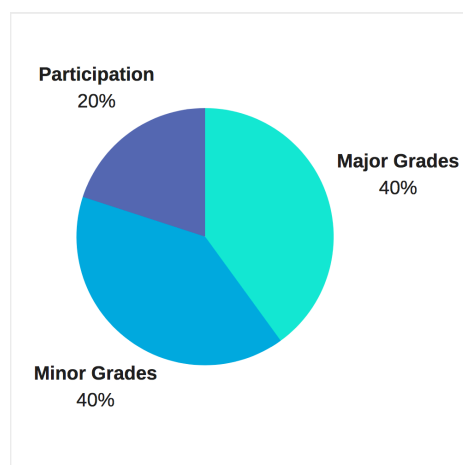


Leadership 1: Step Up

Course Description:

Leadership 1 is the first in a two-part series designed to help students grow as critical and independent thinkers, public speakers, empathetic citizens, and proactive workers. Through the course of this year, students will complete various projects, both individually and in groups, including projects through TED Ed. Leadership students are expected to be proactive and helpful--take charge and lead by example!



Class rules and expectations:

Be kind and respectful. • Come prepared. • Do your best.

Phones will not be tolerated unless I specifically say that you may listen to music (with headphones) or use them for an assignment. Refer to the sign at the front of the room.

Eating and drinking in class will be allowed until it becomes an issue. You should never get out of your seat to share your food or drink for any reason. This includes passing something across the room.

Late policy: For every day that an assignment is late, 10 points will be subtracted from the assignment's grade. Exceptions will be made only in case of absences.
