

## HOW ARE STUDENT FEES USED?

*Dorchester School District Two is authorized by special legislation of the South Carolina Legislature to charge a school fee to be used for instructional materials and programs to benefit students. This \$20 fee stays in your child's school and provides valuable resources that are used in every classroom and throughout the school.*

Examples of supplies or services purchased are as follows:

- ✓ Consumable student text materials (workbooks, lab manuals, enrichment materials)
- ✓ Science equipment and supplies
- ✓ Art materials
- ✓ Music supplies
- ✓ Health and physical education supplies and materials
- ✓ Student incentives (awards, ribbons, prizes)
- ✓ Instructional software
- ✓ Audio visual equipment and resources
- ✓ Supplemental reading materials
- ✓ Dictionaries (class sets)
- ✓ Newspaper in the classroom
- ✓ Classroom sets of books
- ✓ Math manipulatives
