Cafeteria Monitors: Starting Oct. 3, cafeteria monitors and members of the school leadership team will be monitoring students in the cafeteria for lunch. Teachers will be given a well deserved duty free lunch. We will be reviewing cafeteria procedures with students in order to have the safest and cleanest environment for lunch.

Bus Transportation: Parents of K-2 bus riders - Be sure to have bus tag numbers with you daily to show the driver to receive your child. There are frequent subs on buses, so drivers are required to check tag numbers. If the parent does not have the tag, the student has to be returned to the school for pickup. This can lead to suspension from the bus, so have those tags every day!

Afternoon Procedures

Students being picked up before the end of the school day must be signed out in the main office by a person listed on the emergency card with picture I.D. <u>Please do not sign students out during the last 30 minutes of the school day (after 1:35)</u> <u>except for emergencies.</u> If students have afternoon appointments, they should be signed out prior to this time. This is the busiest time for our office staff, and they need to spend their time helping with transportation and afternoon procedures. Any student going home a different way than usual <u>must have a written note from a parent</u> stating the reason for the change in transportation, how the student will be getting home, and a telephone number so the note can be verified, if needed. Riding home on a different bus is generally not allowed. Phone calls for transportation changes <u>WILL NOT</u> be accepted. Faxes are accepted in an emergency & should include a copy of the parent's ID.

Daily pick up needs to be done using the car rider line, not the front office. Students will not be called down to the office after 1:35 until dismissal.

If you live in the vicinity of the school and have your child walk home or you walk to school to pick up your child, please fill out a **walker contract** and return it to the front office. Only those with an approved contract on file will be allowed to pick up children on the sidewalk beyond the lead bus.


