Coronavirus ("COVID-19") One Pager Instructions:

- 1. Use an 8.5 by 11 sheet of paper. (A piece of blank printer paper)
- 2. You will design a visually compelling overview of the Coronavirus pandemic.
- 3. **The entire sheet should be covered**. Use limited pen/pencil. It should be mostly marker or colored pencils to receive full credit.
- 4. Use the article ("When Can We Go To School" from the NYT) as a starting point and add/illustrate the following:
 - a. A quote from that was meaningful to you.
 - b. A striking image.
 - c. A question you have that the article did not address.
- 5. What else should you include on the One-Pager?
 - a. A choropleth map showing coronavirus cases in the world or the United States (use info from the WHO or CDC or the Johns Hopkins GIS dashboard)
 - b. A timeline of the Coronavirus crisis choosing 4 key events
 - c. An infobox containing basic information about COVID-19 (what it is, how it started/where it came from, symptoms, treatment, risks)
 - d. A drawing, image, sentence indicating your emotions about the coronavirus. Are you concerned? If so, what are you concerned about? If so, has learning about COVID-19 alleviated your concerns or increased them?

These are the minimum requirements. You may add to it as you wish. I am NOT grading on artistic ability but on effort. The purpose of this One Pager is for you to make sense of the pandemic; it should reflect your thoughts and feelings about it as well as facts about the disease and what is happening. Remember to use reliable sources.
