School Buildings Open

Students (3rd-12th) receive face-to-face, instruction two days week (MT or WTh) & three days of eLearning at home.

4K-2nd grade will attend 1/2 day five days/week.

The parents of Special Needs students who will be attending full day/ 5 days a week will be contacted by their child's special education teacher.

Preventative practices and health and safety guidelines will be followed.

What does hybrid learning look like?

*Students will attend two days F2F and three days eLearning at home.

Health & Safety Precautions

- Staff, students, and visitors required to wear a face covering
- Social distancing will be planned for and closely monitored for compliance but cannot be guaranteed
- Classroom and bus capacity is reduced for spaced seating
- Frequent cleaning
- Frequent hand washing and increased hand sanitizing stations
- Signage added at entry/exits, restrooms, teacher work rooms, common areas, and hallways as appropriate
- Visitors by appointment only; Sign in/Sign out
- Temperature screenings for all visitors
- Bottle filling stations; no water fountains
- Limited and supervised transitions to avoid group gatherings
- Meet the Teacher, Open House, Awards Ceremonies, field trips, academic competitions, etc. will be virtual events.
- Breakfast and lunch in the classroom
- No use of playground equipment or lockers
- Updated protocols for sick students and

eLearning - Three Days

- Teachers, school counselors, mental health counselors, school psychologists, and administrators will provide social-emotional support regularly
- Use of instructional software, online tools, and recorded lessons
- Continuation of learning based on face-toface instruction
- Virtual collaboration opportunities
- Daily attendance taken
- Fridays: Teachers provide online "live" sessions for all students via Microsoft Teams during designated times

Extended Day

Services provided from 6:45 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. for employees and public.

Transportation

- Bus drivers and students required to wear a face covering.
- Permanent seat assignments mandatory without exception
