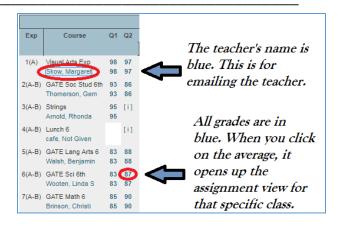
PowerSchool Tips

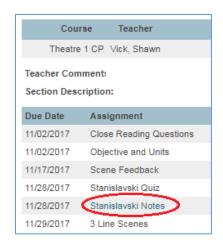
Parents and students, please remember to check PowerSchool at least once every two weeks, more often if you are absent. PowerSchool has many features that you may not know about. These features can be useful to help you better understand your child's grades and progress. More and more teachers are using these features, so if you see them in your child's account, we want you to know how to use them.

If it is blue, it is for you...to click. Not the best rhyme, but it IS an important tip.

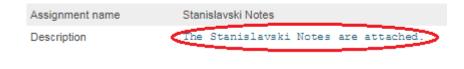
ALL BLUE TEXT leads to more information.

After logging in, the first screen you will usually see is your child's schedule. It includes attendance and grades.





You can see in the image to the left that one of the assignments is in blue font. That means that you can click on it to learn more. When you click on "Stanislavski Notes," the description or message will open (below). Notice that there is *blue text within the message*. Clicking that takes you directly to the assignment.



Finally, teachers can also include *personal* messages to a student about a *specific* assignment. For example, you can see below that the score is <u>underlined</u> and in **blue**. Big hint to click on it.



The personal comment opens when you click on the grade.
